Phase to Full Funding

- o **First Priority:** 0- to 2-year-olds in the following circumstances: experiencing child protection system involved and 3- to 4-year-olds in families up to 185% of federal
- o **Second Priority:** 0- to 2-year-olds up to 100% FPG.
- o **Third Priority:** 0- to 2-year-olds 101% to 185% FPG.
- o **Final Priority:** 0- to 5-year-olds 186 to 300% FPG.
